# Tips

(1)Registration On the VJP website, <https://services.digital.go.jp/visit-japan-web/> ,You can also scan the follow QR code and log in to fill in your personal passport and flight information. Once you finish the registration, you'll receive a QR code. Be sure to take a screenshot of it for easy access during entry! No need to fill in the paper version information again.

The filling method can be obtained from Tiktok related videos. The QR code is as follows:

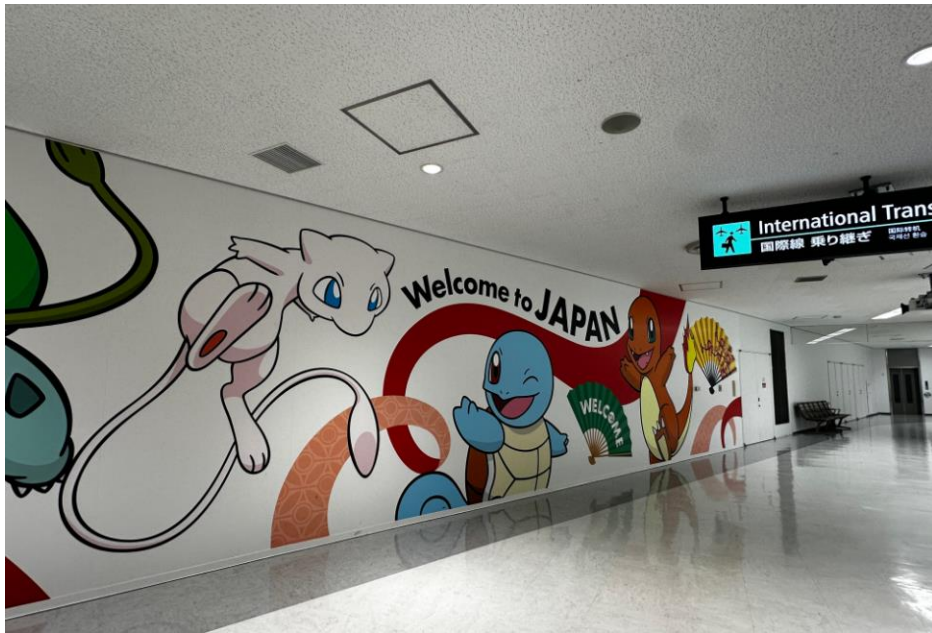
(2)It is important to know which items are allowed upon entry, as well as the size and weight restrictions for luggage, to prevent customs confiscation.

(3)Essential items include: passport, ID card, JRPass reservation form, Appropriate Japanese yen (**cash payment is still required in many places**), phone card, common medications (for colds, motion sickness, gastrointestinal discomfort, etc.), toiletries, indoor slippers, warm jacket, sports shoes, portable water bottle, and travel insurance.

(4)Meat products, fruits, and certain prohibited items cannot be carried into the country.

(5)Install Google Maps software on your phone for easy navigation, collection, and finding stations.

After arriving at Narita Airport by plane, follow the signs to find the exit, prepare a screenshot of the QR code registered on VJP in advance, prepare your passport, handle entry procedures, and retrieve your luggage.



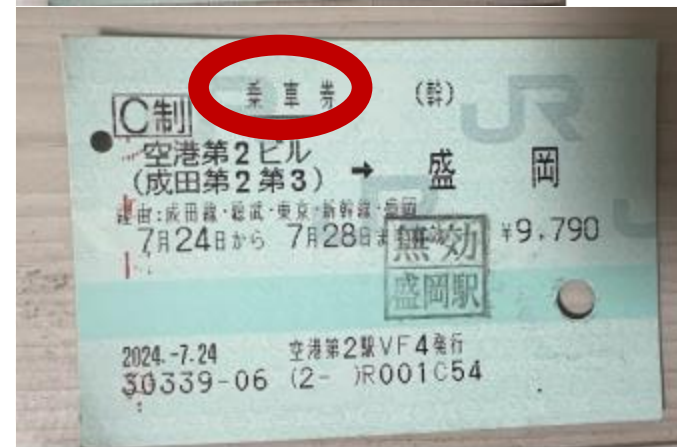
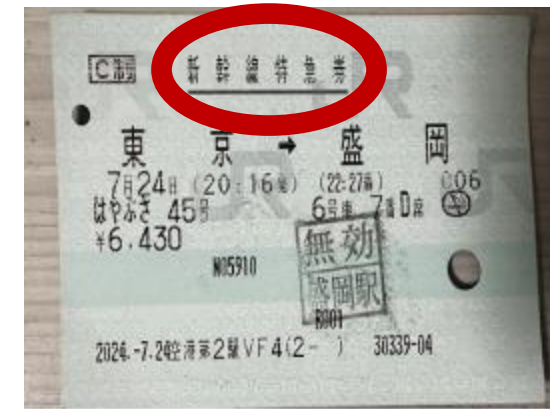
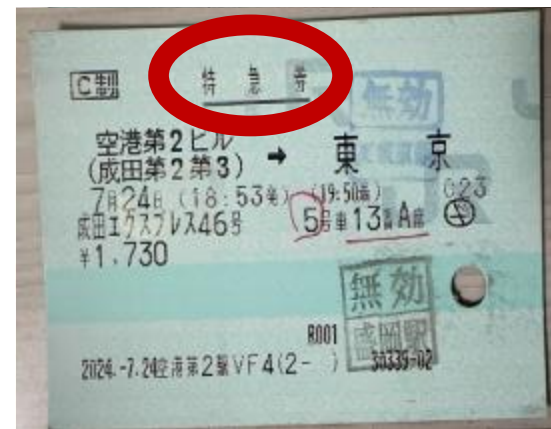
**After arriving at Narita Airport, some icons along the way**

To find the JR railway logo, you can purchase tickets at the vending machine (no passport required) by selecting the time slot and destination. You can also choose your own seat in the carriage. Please note that you need to purchase **two train tickets** (one for boarding and the other for express trains on the Shinkansen).





When purchasing tickets, you can choose English as the language and select JR. Cash payment or watermelon card payment is available. Due to the relatively large size of Tokyo Station, sufficient time was allotted for boarding and changing tickets. 1 ticket for Airport Line 2- Morioka (by train), 2 tickets for Airport Line 2- Tokyo, Tokyo - Morioka (by express)



After purchasing the ticket, pay attention to the platform, train number, and seat number on the ticket, and find the boarding point according to the following picture (you can also navigate on Google Maps or ask the staff), then take the train from the airport to Tokyo.

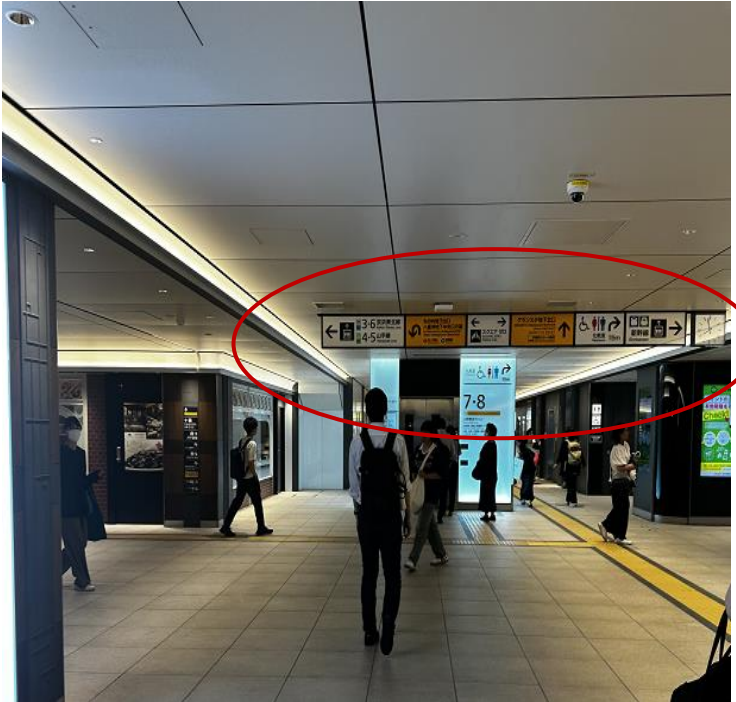




After arriving in Tokyo, follow the picture below to find the train and take the elevator from the airport express platform to **B1** underground. As the Tokyo station of Narita Express is located on the **5th** underground floor. So look at the signs on the elevator, the signs are very clear, find a transfer to the Shinkansen platform.

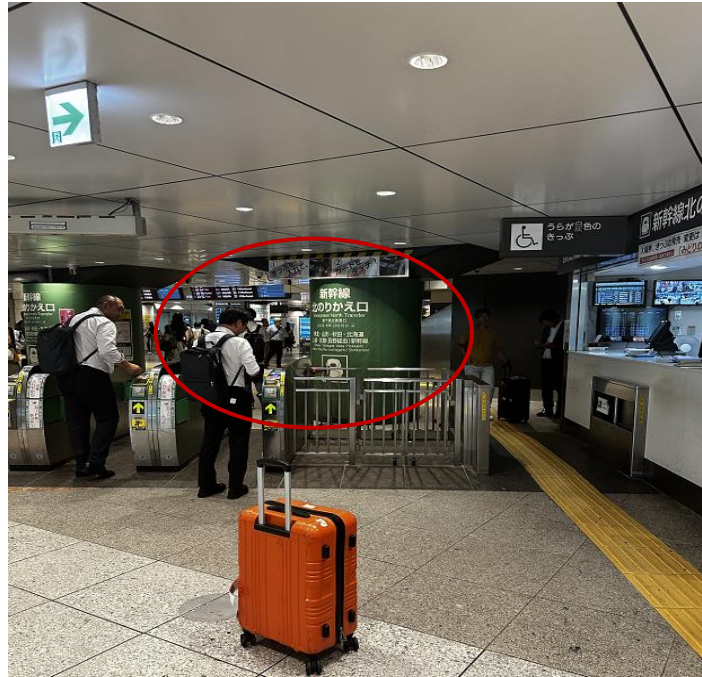
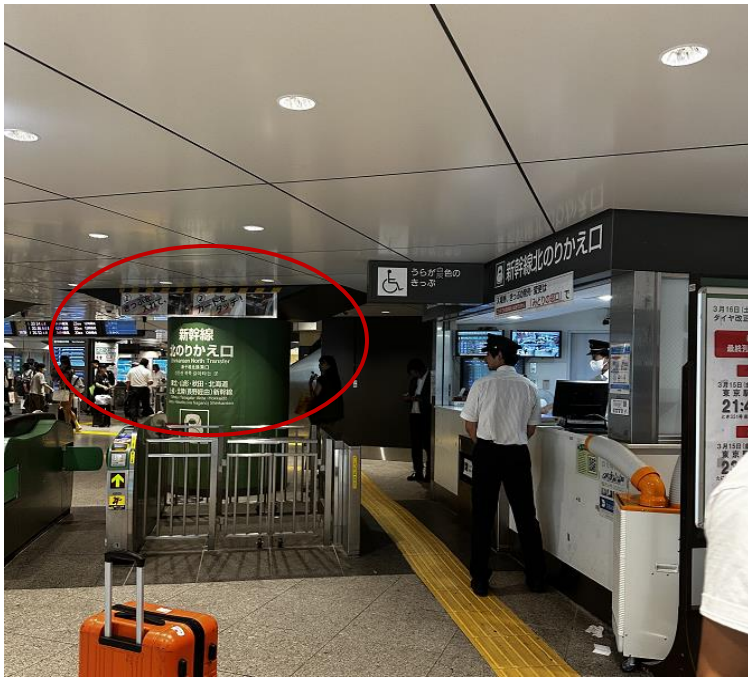


Look for a sign to get on the elevator and find a transfer to the Shinkansen platform.



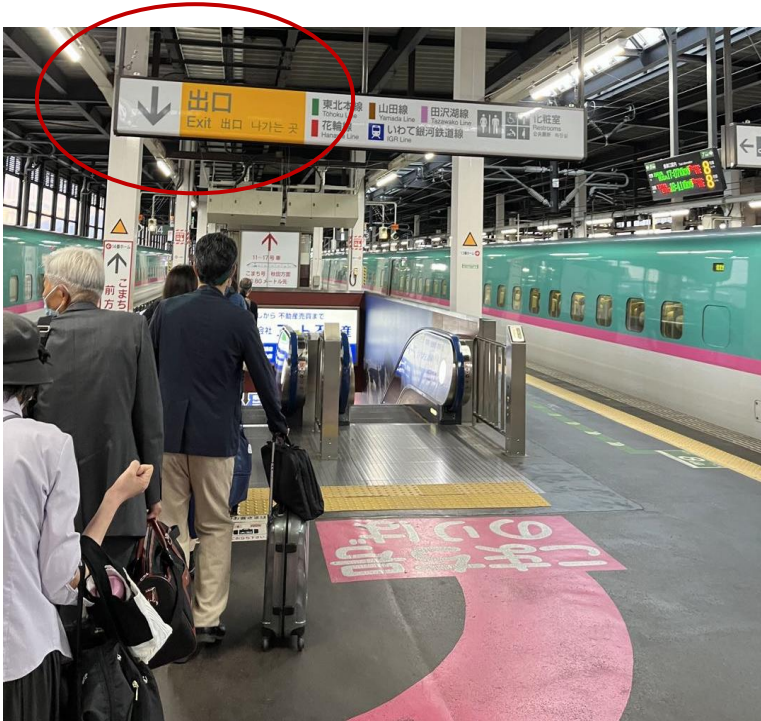


Change Tōhoku Shinkansen at the ticket counter. Please confirm your train number on platform **20-23** before you board the train. When you arrive at the station, take the train to Morioka. Japanese train tickets are generally recycled into the ticket machine. **Note to reserve tickets, please go to the second left picture below the artificial channel.**



**Artificial access**

Pay attention to the public announcement or get off the train in time after arriving at the station according to the ticket information, so as to avoid making mistakes and get to Morioka Station from **the southern gate**.
